Nora Hurley Chuck Cavano recommended that the Board consider revising paragraphs 9 and 19, to explicitly state that the cost of both transcribing and transmitting the record for an appeal to Common Pleas Court must be borne solely by the Appellant (i.e., the debarred contractor). Discussion ensued, and Board members agreed that this would be beneficial. Evan stated that he would circulate the recommendation among Debarment Board members for consideration via email, and revise the rule if a consensus is achieved.

Bob Triozzi recommended that the Debarment Board consider adding a provision that allows for a dissatisfied Appellant to file a Motion for Reconsideration from a Board ruling. Discussion ensued, and Evan agreed that he would take this recommendation back to the Board for further discussion and consideration.
