1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Simon at 11:30 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

The Clerk called the roll. Committee members Simon and Jones were in attendance and a quorum was established. Ms. Connally was absent.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

4. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FROM THE 4.15.2011 MEETING

5. OVERVIEW REGARDING THE PROGRESSION OF THE NEW JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER

Judge Tom O'Malley, Administrative Judge for the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court and Ms. Marita Kavalec, Court Administrator, addressed the committee regarding logistical concerns of the move to the new facility. They asked that they be given at least 60 days notice to make the move.

Jeff Mowry, Chief Information Officer, addressed the IT concerns. He stated that he needs at least two to three weeks to make a plan before committing to a completion date.

Ms. Simon stated that the committee is still waiting for a decision from the Office of the Ohio Attorney General regarding the Law Department.
